Dear Parents

As part of our residential week activities, your child will have the exciting opportunity to visit New Forest Wildlife Park on Tuesday 17th June. New Forest Wildlife Park is a fantastic local attraction where children can explore a collection of indigenous species in their natural surroundings. To save on costs, please **drop off your child at the Wildlife Park at 9:30am**. They will then need **collecting at 3pm**.

In addition to this trip, on Wednesday 18th June, the children will be visiting Moors Valley for a day of team building and fun in the forest. And finally, on Thursday 19th June, in the morning, we will be heading to Ten Pin in Southampton for some bowling. For these trips, we will be using the school mini-bus to further reduce costs. For these trips, we will be leaving school at approximately 9.00am and returning by approximately 11.30am. On each of these days, children will need to be dropped off and collected at the normal school time.

The total contribution required for the week will be **£25**. We hope you will feel able to support these events, as we feel it will be both an educational and enjoyable experience. Please return the attached permission slip, with money by **Thursday 5th June**.

For the Tuesday and Wednesday trips, your child will need to:

- Wear their own clothes and trainers, which you are happy to get a little dirty.
- Bring suitable clothing for the weather (rain coat and trousers in case of poor weather).
- Hat and suncream
- Bring a snack and drink (not fizzy) to have throughout the morning.
- Bring a packed lunch (a picnic lunch will be provided for children who are entitled to free school dinners) and an extra drink (not fizzy) to have throughout the day.
- On Thursday, children must wear clean, closed-toe trainers to be able to take part in the bowling.

Please note that, as these are extra-curricular activities, we will make alternative arrangements in the school for your child if you are not happy to pay. We will accept payments by instalments, if this helps you: please speak to the office team.
